Old uniforms were discussed as selling as a fundraiser to put towards cost of new uniforms. Brenda requested to know the number of old obsolete uniforms to sell. Ryall will get a count. Brenda will post on alumni Facebook page cost of old uniforms at \$20.00 and \$50 if signed by past/present conductors.

Band banquet planning needs to start and Lacy and Brenda stated they will start to get estimates for pens and glasses to find better prices than previous years. There are 27 seniors this year.

Pam is working on programs through Minuteman Press for winter concert. She orders and the boosters pay for them. Amanda made a motion to pay for the programs with the amount not to exceed \$300.00. Seconded by April. Motion carried.

Brian reported Project Bridge concert will be on February 26th at 2pm. in the LHS theatre. All are encouraged to attend.

Pam requested \$800 to pay for solo/ensemble accompanists from OU. They will be on hand for 2 practices and for the whole day of the event. Ryan made a motion to pay the \$800 fee with each student anticipated to make payment costs of \$20.00 apiece. Seconded by Brian. Motion carried.

Vicki had two thank you cards undeliverable with no addresses from fall festival. Amanda stated it is her family and she will take them to distribute.

Next meeting is scheduled for February 13th, 2023 at 6:30 in the LHS band room.
