Minutes from Meeting: Sept. 8th, 2016

Meeting called to order by Missy Mullins @ 6:30. There were 10 members in attendance.

SECRETARY'S REPORT was read for the month of August and motion to accept by Rochelle Hanson; seconded by Barb Nakanishi.

OLD BUSINESS

- Thank you to all who helped in the month of August with uniform distribution, band camp, scrimmage concessions, alumni band practice, and Parade of the Hills.
- Thank you letters were sent to Dairy Queen, Movies 10, Pizza Crossing, Domino's, and Olde Dutch for their donations and support during band camp.
- Yankee Candle fundraiser packets were handed out at parent's night. Order forms due on Sept. 5th but on-line orders can be placed through end of December.
- Seniors were provided an opportunity to purchase a Senior Banner to be hung up for every home game. Banners were provided by Hocking Hill Sign Company for \$24.
- New T-shirt design was created with this year's moto. This year's shirt prices will be set at \$13 each or 2 for \$25.
- Visitor side coffee machine is still not done and the vent fans still need to be installed as well.

NEW BUSINESS

Oakbrook Fund raiser will run for two weeks starting on September 21st. Products will be delivered on October 18th. Volunteers will be needed to help sort and distribute products once it arrives. Proceeds will go in the Band Club fund to help pay for the band banquet in the spring.

Fair booth set up scheduled for Saturday, September 10th at 10:00. Current issues inside the booth include leaking left faucet and a leaky drain. Unsure if hot water has been turned on yet. Brenda Rowe made a motion to renew the contract for next year. Motion was seconded by Rochelle Hanson. Motion passed so the contract will be renewed during Fair Week.

Betsy sent information regarding the proposed Field House donation and recommended that we pledge \$10,000 to be paid out over the course of the next 5 years. Everyone agreed with this plan.

Fall Festival of Bands is scheduled for Saturday, Oct. 1st @ 6 pm. Eleven bands will be performing, including Logan.
